### Tabs 2008 Pocket PC Released

At last the waiting is over. Our 2008 new edition of Tabs for pocket PC has been released to the team and is in the final stages of testing. Tabs for Pocket PC was initially written in a programming language called Microsoft Embedded Visual Basic, first released by Microsoft in 1996. This programming language was the best choice available for our developers at the time. 12 Years later this programming language is no longer supported by Microsoft and offers limited functionality compared with newer programming languages.

As from August 2008 Tabs FM hand held software is in a newer programming language called Microsoft C#. (The latest incarnation of which has only been released this year).

By rewriting Tabs for Pocket PC, we can take advantage of many of the new features found within the new programming language and also newer versions of Windows Mobile based devices. This will ultimately lead to a large number of improvements in the software.

Some general improvements that will be obtained from rewriting the software are as follows:

- Quicker synchronization of data between the mobile device and database server  
*Newer versions of SQL Server for Windows Mobile offer improved data transfer speeds*
- Improved compatibility with a wider range of Windows-Based Mobile Devices  
*Mobile Devices that support different screen resolutions and latest versions of Windows Mobile*
- Improved connectivity with GPRS, ActiveSync & Wireless LAN  
*The new version of the software will be able to initiate connections if required*



A sample of modified areas is as follows:

#### Only download data that is relevant to your operation

*The new Tabs for Pocket PC system is intelligent when retrieving and uploading data from the remote database and will not download any information that is irrelevant to the modules you are using.*

#### Greater control over features

*System settings for the software have been designed from the ground up to be logical, simple, and powerful to use. A greater degree of control is available for system administrators to customise Tabs for Pocket PC on a global or per user basis.*

#### Streamlined user interface

*The new version of Tabs for Pocket PC has a graphically improved user interface that allows users to navigate around tabs with the minimum of effort. New menus and forms look uncluttered whilst retaining the strengths of the existing functionality. A 'switchboard' will look and feel similar to the main Tabs system.*

#### Simplified setup and configuration

*A new configuration wizard will allow users to setup Tabs on their mobile device with a minimum amount of effort.*

#### Redesigned modules

*Modules are designed and adjusted to better suit the needs of the user. They've been developed to be consistent with the methods used by the current Tabs Management Information System and Tabs intranet System. The Asset Tracking, PAT and Fixed Electrical Testing modules conform to current legislation (where applicable).*

#### Multiple Connectivity

*The new Tabs for Pocket PC system now offers the functionality to configure multiple connections. This provides your mobile workforce with the ease and ability to connect to base either Internal or External to your organisations network.*

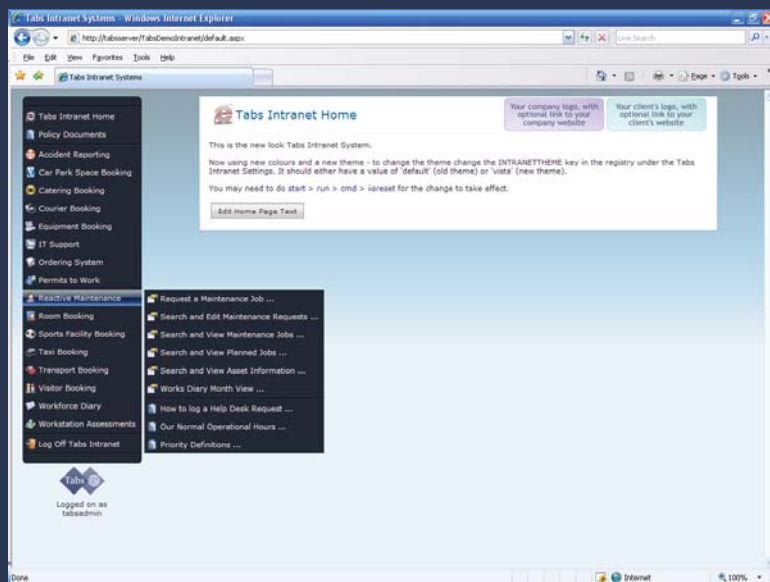
### Other Tabs Development...
